1923 - 1999

Barbara R. Bingham, age 76 of Pigeon, passed away Sunday morning October 10, in Caseville, after a lingering illness.

She was born on September 19, 1923 in Highland Park, the daughter of the late Herbert and Dorothy (Fielding) Randall. On November 23, 1943 she was united in marriage to Lawrence L. Bingham in Berkley.

In 1975 she and her husband retired to Sand Point. He preceded her in death in 1977. Before moving to Pigeon, Mrs. Bingham worked at the Yarncraft Shop and the Bargain Box Store of the Junior League, both in Birmingham. She enjoyed knitting and sewing.
