Mr. Gerald F. Herp, 70, of Bad Axe, retired football coach of Ubly Community Schools, passed away Thursday morning, Nov. 19, 2009 at the Huron Medical Center in Bad Axe. He was born at the family home in Burnips to Gerald and Irma (Goodman) Herp on Oct. 29, 1939. He married Elrae Nugent on March 25, 1972 at the First Presbyterian Church in Bad Axe. He was a 1957 graduate of Hopkins High School where he lettered in football, baseball and basketball. His college career began at Hope College, where he played football, and continued at Central Michigan University, where he obtained a bachelors degree in education. His true love was high school football, which he coached for over 30 years. He had league championship teams in 1965, 1966, 1967, 1968, 1970, 1971, 1972 (undefeated season), 1987,1988 and 1995. His teams made the high school playoffs in 1992 and 1995. One of his proudest moments was being inducted to the Michigan High School Football Coaches Hall of Fame in 2000.
