SEPTEMBER 6, 2019 – Truro Township is pleased to announce that Setterlin Building Company of Columbus has signed an interim agreement to complete construction of the Truro Township Fire Station 161, located at 6900 E. Main Street. Setterlin was selected by The Ohio Farmers Insurance Company/Westfield Group, the project's surety bonding company.

Setterlin Building Company is a family owned commercial construction company that has provided outstanding construction services throughout central and southern Ohio. Established in 1935, Setterlin has been providing award-winning construction services that have had a lasting impact on their clients and communities for generations.

The fire station project had been stalled since February, when the general contractor, Palmetto Construction Services, voluntarily defaulted on its contract to build the fire station. The 16,000-square foot building is being constructed on the same site as the previous station. Once completed, the station will consist of three apparatus bays, living quarters for shift personnel, a training room and administrative offices.

Today, the Truro Township Fire Department serves the citizens of Truro Township, the City of Reynoldsburg and Village of Brice and protects an area of approximately nine square miles. In 2018, the fire department responded to 7,396 runs – 6,227 EMS runs, 1,108 fire runs and 61 for the community paramedic program.
