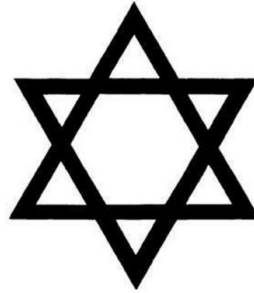




Alfred David WINTERS

He returned safely to raise a family in the New Haven area, moving through several jobs, retail and wholesale sales, most notably, selling toys for the Harold Hahn Co. in North Haven, Connecticut.

Al and Dorothy (Dottie) Soucy were married on August 23, 1969 and lived in Bristol, Connecticut until moving to Jacksonville, Florida in 1973. He loved his family dearly and took great pride and joy in his grandchildren and great grandchildren. Second only to his family, he loved the Marine Corps. It was an endless source of pride and he never tired of meeting new Marines and swapping stories. He was an active member of the Marine Corps League in Jacksonville, shared his experiences freely with junior ROTC groups in the area and was a familiar sight at parades and fund-raising events.
