This month the Trustees would like to make everyone aware of a general price increase beginning June 1. It has been over 5 years since our last price increase and the prices we pay continue to rise. The Aerie is having a tough time making a profit due to increasing general costs. Remember, in order to support our mission of people helping people, we need to make more than we spend. The increase will be as follows:

- Cans and bottles of beer \$.50
- Draft beer \$.50
- House liquor well drinks no increase
- All other liquor \$.50
- All non-house liquor mixed drinks \$.75
- All wine \$.50

Again, if anyone has any references for a cook or wants to volunteer to cook sometime during the week, please contact Loni.

Please remember that every bar worker, wait staff, kitchen workers, and event persons you see is a volunteer, giving up their time to support the Aerie. BE NICE TO THEM. Without them we wouldn't have a club. They deserve your respect and patience!

Remember, when you come into the Aerie bar, it is your responsibility, and state liquor law, to show your card to the bartender. Do not make them ask you to see it and if they ask you multiple times throughout the night, show them multiple times without contempt. It is their job and the law.
