### **Directions from Atlanta, GA:**

Take

I-20 West to Exit 185 (Anniston/Oxford). Merge right onto Alabama Highway 21 North. Go through Oxford, Anniston/McClellan, and the Jacksonville square (about 20 miles). You will see the 12-story Houston Cole Library on the right and the marble University sign on the left. The entrance to the university is on your left. ## **Contest Information**

**At the time of the Contest, Jacksonville will be in Central Time. Please plan your travel and arrival time accordingly. Ticket booth gates will open usually an hour before the first performance.**

## **Spectator Parking**

**The main spectator lots are located on the south side of the stadium off of Mountain St. and the west side of the stadium off of Forney Ave.**

**There is a \$5 charge for parking in all lots.**

**All other campus parking will be free of charge and available for spectator use.**

### ***BUS DRIVER / CHAPERONES***
