

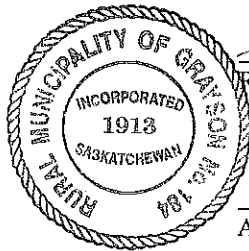


BYLAW 2:2008

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Grayson No. 184, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. Property and other taxes imposed by the Rural Municipality of Grayson No. 184 are deemed to be imposed on the first day of January in each year and shall be due on December 31<sup>st</sup>.
2. Taxes which remain unpaid after the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December of the year in which they are levied shall be subject to a penalty.
  - (i) Where arrears of taxes are collected, a penalty in an amount equal to .75% of the amount of the arrears collected, per month for each full month or portion of a month that the arrears of taxes remain unpaid during that year, shall also be collected.
  - (ii) Where the whole or a portion of the taxes remain unpaid, a penalty of 9% per year of the unpaid tax arrears shall be added to the tax roll on December 31<sup>st</sup> of any year succeeding the year in which the taxes were levied.
3. The effective date of this bylaw shall be January 1, 2008.
4. Bylaw 6-2007 is hereby repealed.
