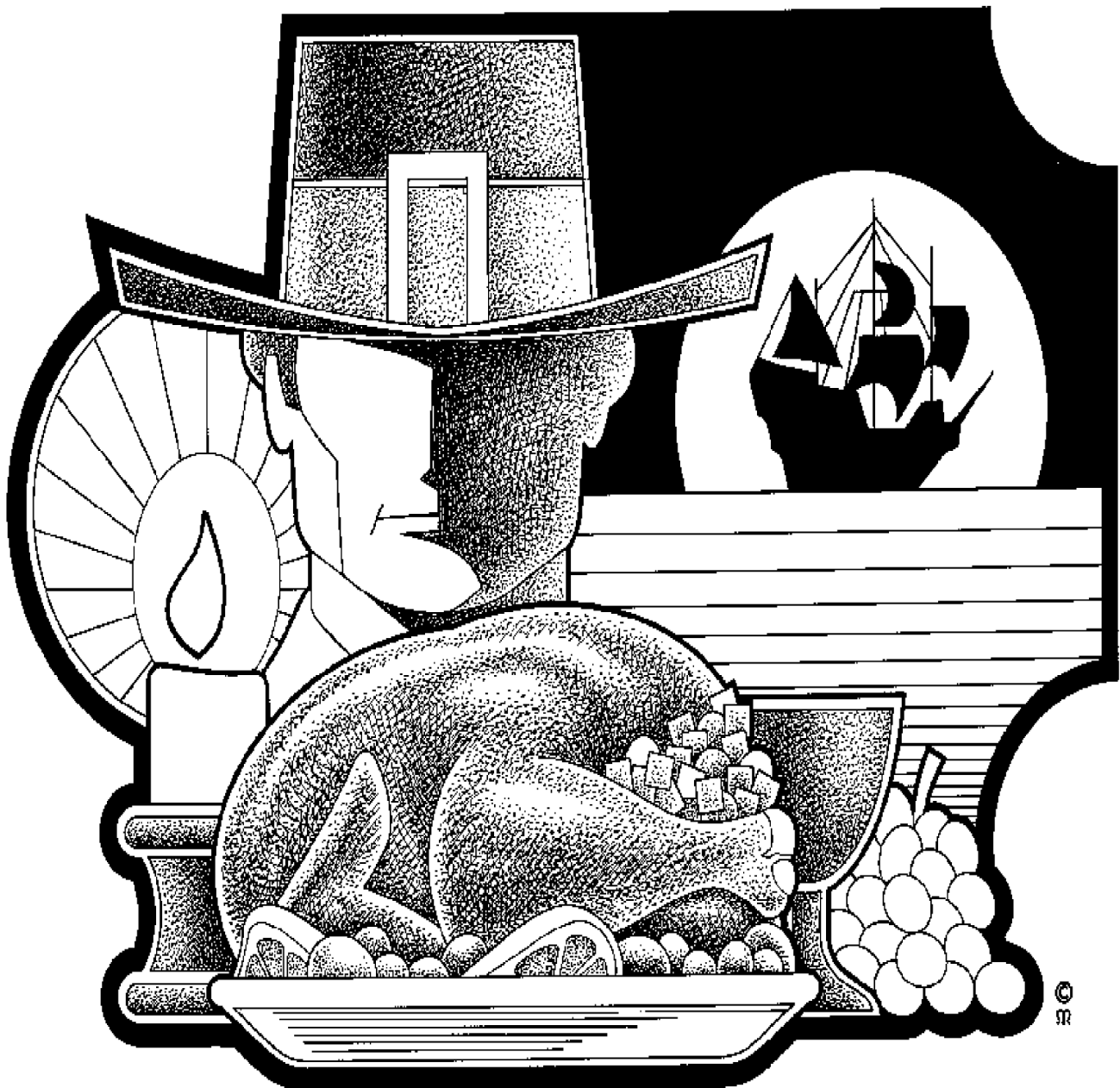

# Broward County - 2010 Census: It's In Our Hands



Census 2010 is just six months away! Broward County Commissioner Ilene Lieberman, chair of the Complete Count Committee, will host a Census Partners Expo on Thursday, November 5, 2009, from 9:00 – 11:00 a.m. The Expo is an opportunity for community partners to network with fellow members of the Complete Count Committee, find out what is available to promote the Census, share your organization's plans and explore collaborative opportunities. ## The Census Is Coming - April 1, 2010



### Ten Minutes Every Ten Years

The U.S. Constitution requires a national census once every 10 years. Census forms will be mailed to every household in March 2010 and Census Day is April 1, 2010. In Broward County, more than 800,000 housing units will receive the Census! The brief questionnaire takes about 10 minutes to complete, and asks for the name, gender, age, race, ethnicity and relationship to the householder, and whether the householder owns or rents their home. You should fill out your census form wherever you are on the day you receive it, regardless of where you live at other times of the year.



### It's Safe to Complete the Census

Don't be afraid to be counted, even if you are not a documented resident. Census forms are completely confidential for 72 years and cannot be shared with anyone, including welfare and immigration agencies. No court of law, not even the President of the United States, can access your individual responses. Census workers are highly motivated to protect your answers – they are subject to a \$250,000 fine and/or a five-year prison term for disclosing any information that could identify a respondent or household.



### Census Results Determine Funding for Community Projects

Governments use census data to allocate billions of dollars in funding for education, public safety, housing, roads and bridges, human services and community services. Community organizations use it to develop social service programs for seniors and children, and businesses use it to identify where to locate factories, shopping centers, movie theaters, banks and offices – activities that lead to new jobs! The loss in funding for government services for just one uncounted person in Broward County was estimated at \$1,300 by the 2000 Census Monitoring Board. An undercounting of 1,000 residents could mean a loss in funding for Broward County of \$1.3 million or more!



### Population Determines Representation

Census data is also used to determine representation in the federal and state legislatures. Undercounting results in under-representation.

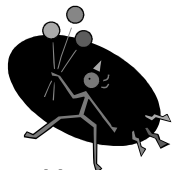

**RULES ROUND-UP** Love 'em or hate 'em, the rules are the rules  
The goal of this monthly article is to remind us of the current by-laws and rules. Hopefully, it will promote compliance, discussion and revision if needed.  
This is OUR community. We all share the common goal of living in a beautiful neighborhood and increasing our property values.

This is an excerpt of the subject matter of our by-laws.

**Pg 7 Section 111. Homesite Owner's Rights**

"...owner shall have the right to use the Association Areas in accordance for which they are intended, but no such use shall hinder or encroach upon the lawful rights of the owners of other homesites and subject always to the right of the Association, including correction of any undesirable, unhealthful or unaesthetic appearances..."

**Pg 8 Section VI. Landscaping**

"...The owner of each individual Homesite shall be responsible for maintaining the Association Areas abutting his Homesite on all four (4) sides thereof to a depth of five (5) feet (clearance for landscaper vehicles required) from the outbounds of his Homesite..."

**First Impression Property Values! Everyone wants home sale prices to go up. Let's all do our part! We all need to maintain the five feet around our homes.**

§ Concrete green, black, moldy or dirty? A little bleach and a broom will remove that mold. (Mold causes breathing problems)

§ Bushes, ivy, hedges; plantings of any sort, need to be trimmed regularly, at minimum every 30 days. Weeding needs to be done monthly, use mulch and landscape screen to hinder growth.

§ Gutters and Downspouts – If bent, broken or disconnected repair, remove, replace

§ Dirty, broken and over grown concrete barriers, broken or unused flower pots, extra trash containers, and "stuff" stored outdoors is unsightly and lowers price & value in the minds and pocketbooks of buyers.

§ Screen doors or window screens torn? Repair or replacement screen and spline can be purchased at Home Dept and Lowe's. Not only is it ugly, critters will enter your home.

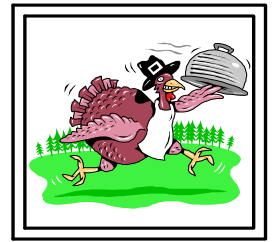
