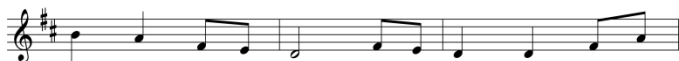

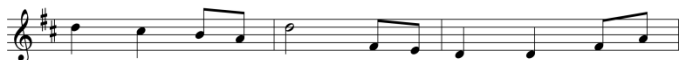

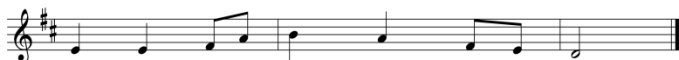

Son,

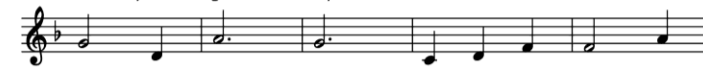
who with the Father and the Son is adored and
