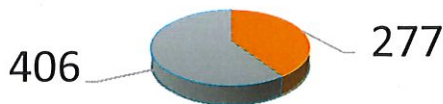
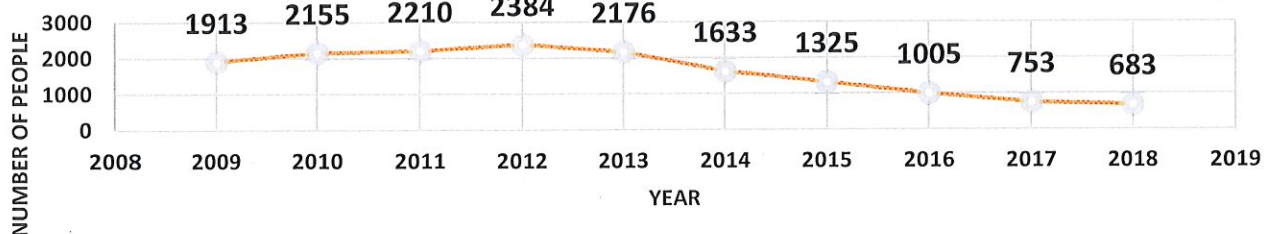

Top 3 Needs Identified

Affordable Housing: **54.1%**
Shelter: **53.6%**
Food/Meals: **47.3%**

16.5% from **out of state**

Top 3 Identified Causes of Homelessness

Employment/Financial Reasons: **33.8%**
Housing Issues: **21.5%**
Medical/Disability: **13.6%**
