Letter from the Baron:

Well met!

Happy August. By the time this edition of the Village Idiot is out, Pennsic 45 will already be started. For those of you going, safe travels, and have a good war. For those staying home, well, maybe next year, right?

If you've never been to Pennsic, you should go, at least once, if only for the experience of camping out with 10,000 of your best friends. Also if you've never been, Pennsic is an annual war between the East Kingdom (second oldest) and their allies, and the Middle Kingdom (third oldest) and their allies.

Northshield has allied with the East this year, and will be fighting against the Middle, alongside the East, Calontir, and Ealdormere, among others. This is a neat historical bit, as far as I know, because it is the first time the Midrealm's three descendent kingdoms have ALL allied with the East.

This also means September is right around the corner, which means FALL CORONATION is also right around the corner, September 10th in Border Downs (Yankton, SD). This will be another historic first, as Northshield will be investing the first same-gender pair of Crown and Consort anywhere in the SCA. While they are not a romantic couple (at least not with each other...) this is still a huge first for the SCA. There will be LOTS of people coming in from out-of-kingdom to attend this historic first.

Plan to attend. Make your reservations NOW. Coronation is, in part, a "big show" event, so pretty up your gear. If you see strangers at Coronation, be sure to greet them. If they are from out of kingdom, be sure to thank them for coming. If they are Northshielders you haven't met yet, be sure to greet them like the long-lost kin that they are. Lots of fun stuff is happening at the local level. Monday night fencing in Appleton is alternating with pell work with Hamish up in GB. Wednesday night project night is ongoing. Lady Nimeau has been running Saturday classes on a variety of A&S activities. And Sunday practice continues to alternate between Appleton and Green Bay.

Poorman's Pensic is August 12-14, next door in Falcon's Keep. This is also a public demo on Saturday, so if you know someone who is interested in the SCA, that may be a good introduction.

Baronial Policies Review:

A group met to review the Baronial Policies. The current policies can be found on our website under Library. The proposed changes will be reviewed and voted on at our next meeting. The proposed changes are: I. General Policies

A) There are no requirements for participation within the Barony. Participation is not constrained by the boundaries as defined by the Kingdom Cartographer.

C) Sovereigns of Northshield are not expected to pay site or feast fees; this privilege would extend to their Heirs in the Sovereigns' absence. Waiving of fees for other visiting royalty must be individually approved at a business meeting or a quorum of Greater Officers.

Remove original D

D) The Village Idiot is a monthly publication, twelve issues per year, and each issue shall be published on the website

F) A printed copy is Available upon request

II. Great Officers

A) Remove Chiurgeon

C) Greater Officers have a two year term, renewable upon publication in the Village Idiot for two months and subsequent vote.

III. Lesser Officers

A) Lesser Officers include several offices that, while subordinate to Great Offices, are not required by Corpora or Kingdom Law unless noted, but considered main parts of Windhaven's government. Lesser officers have a term of 2 years, renewable upon publication in the Village Idiot for two months and subsequent

6. Emergency Exchequer Deputy (required – reports to Windhaven Exchequer)

IV. Event Stewards

A) Any Baronial member wishing to organize an official event must present a written proposal to the business meeting. The proposal must include a description of the theme, activities, estimated budget and location of the proposed event. Baronial Requests for bid proposals will be posted in the VI and the baronial email list for two months prior to submission deadline. Kingdom level events and above are exempted from this policy.

V. Financial Policies

A) A receipt and Cash Reimbursement Request Form must accompany all expense reimbursement requests.

I) The financial committed consists of Seneshcal, Exchequer and any other paid members voting at the meeting.

VI. Baronial Transition Policies

D. The requirements to be a candidate

1 Must have been active in Windhaven for one year preceding nomination, and plays with Windhaven (if lives inside the boundaries but mainly plays outside Windhaven, not qualified.)

Remove 3.

Experience

 a. Has served as a greater officer

4. The Seneschal or the Exchequer may not cohabitate, be the significant other to or be married to either the Baron or Baroness.

E) Nomination and Balloting procedures

1. Nomination procedures

b. remove candidates must be nominated by someone other than themselves.

- 2. Balloting and Interviewing
 - a. Remove "and sign"

e. The Seneschal shall follow Northshield Baronial Transitions Policy in conducting the interviews and initial polling. If an outside moderator is used, s/he must be approved by the members of the Barony. This moderator will ensure that these policies are followed, as well as those of Kingdom laws and SCA policy. They will tabulate the initial polling and forward the results to the Royalty and Kingdom Seneschal.

g. Once the three highest candidates for Baron and/or Baroness have been chosen and announced by the outside moderator, these candidates' names will be forwarded to Royalty and the Kingdom Seneschal, or their designated deputy, to be placed on the final ballot.

3. Absentee Ballots

a. A member of the populace may email the Seneschal to receive an absentee ballot for the

preliminary balloting at least 1 week in advance.

VII. Baronial Awards

F) Hospitaller's Chalice: For showing outstanding hospitality to members of the Barony and its guests. Closed

G) Vert Sparks: For people new to the society and barony who have become involved and shown their support through service in the College of Bentbridge.




