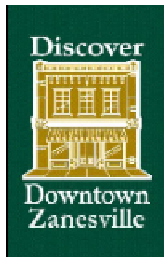

Stained-glass artist, wife and mother, Patty Bright, also hails from the Zanesville area. Patty grew up on a farm in Morgan county and has always been creative in one way or another throughout her life. She has been creating stained glass for over 15 years and her works can be seen in businesses and private collections across the country. Patty draws visual and spiritual inspiration for her pieces from the imperfections of nature.
