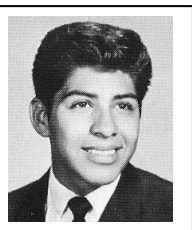

What's New?

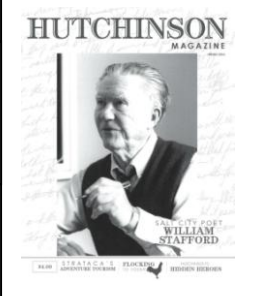

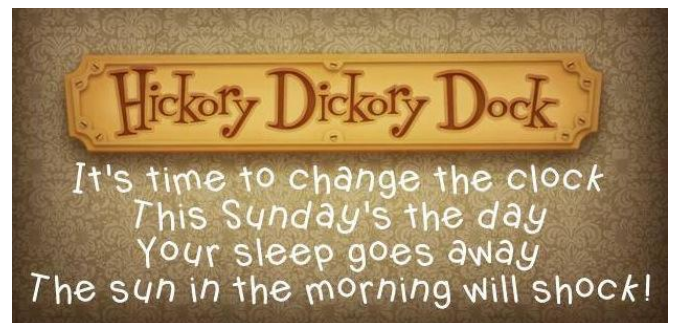

An old, unused feed mill in southeast Hutchinson is heading – stubbornly – to its demise. Gary Gorby, owner of G&G Dozier Co., Caney, said they started cutting it so it would fall over, but "it just sat back down." More equipment and another effort today were expected to bring down the approximately 85-foot-tall structure near the intersection of

Midwest Superstore Collision Repair Center employee Keith Winter removes the window controls from the door panel on a car Feb. 19 at the Hutchinson Career and Technical Education Building on at Hutchinson High School. A fire at Midwest Superstore Feb. 14 will have the dealership's auto body repair working at the high school for the next three to six weeks.

There were 13 cars inside the building at the time of the fire, and some received smoke damage. They are currently waiting for the insurance company to complete its evaluation of the damage.

Many of the vehicles they were working on were in for hail damage repair from the summer.

Meanwhile, Midwest asked if students enrolled in the program could work alongside their trained employees as apprentices. They will be getting first-hand experience from four body men, an assistant, a part-time body man, two painters and a detail guy who cleans the cars after they have been repaired.

"The students will be getting real experience," said Blaine Murphy a HCTEA instructor who team-teaches auto body and collision repair with Brad Yoder. Generally, the students work on cars brought in for repairs by staff and others in the community.

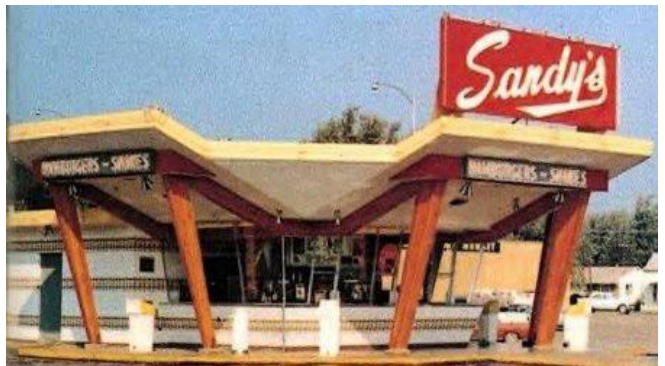
