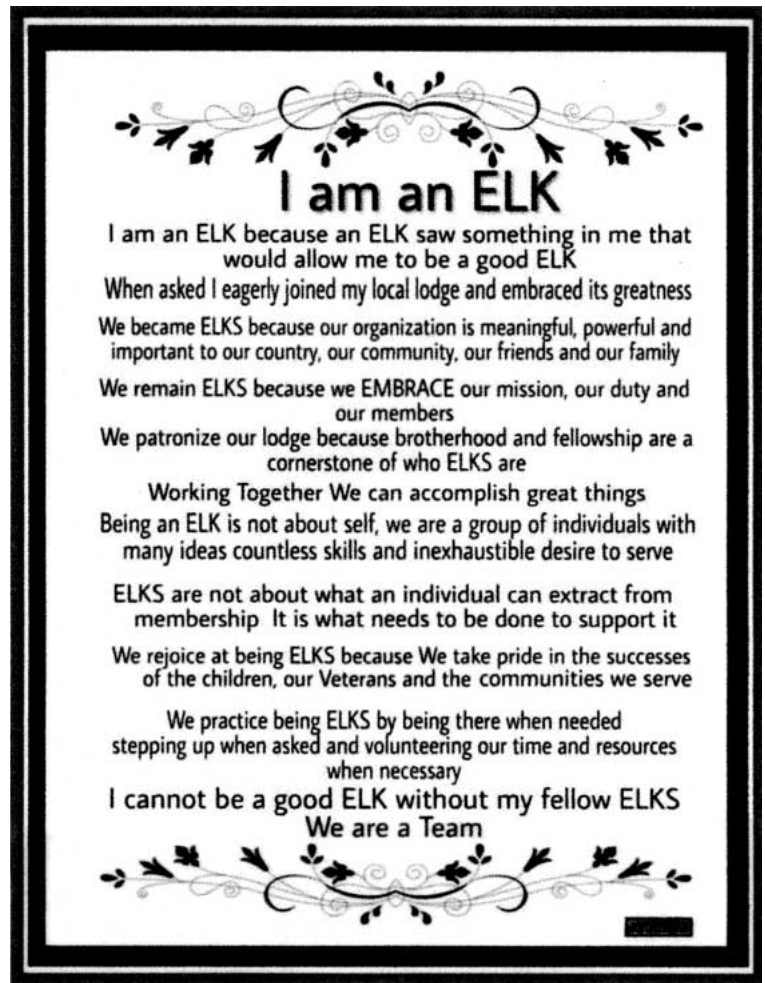
I am happy to see that the seal coating of the parking lot is finished. This is something that has been needed to be done for a long time.
