Section 6 of Local No. 1 for the year 1978 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6. REDEMPTION OF SEIZED DOGS.

(a) Every dog seized pursuant to this Local Law or the provisions of the Agricultural and Markets Law of the State of New York shall be immediately delivered by the Dog Warden to the Shelter for Dogs, as established by the Town of Cohocton, New York.
