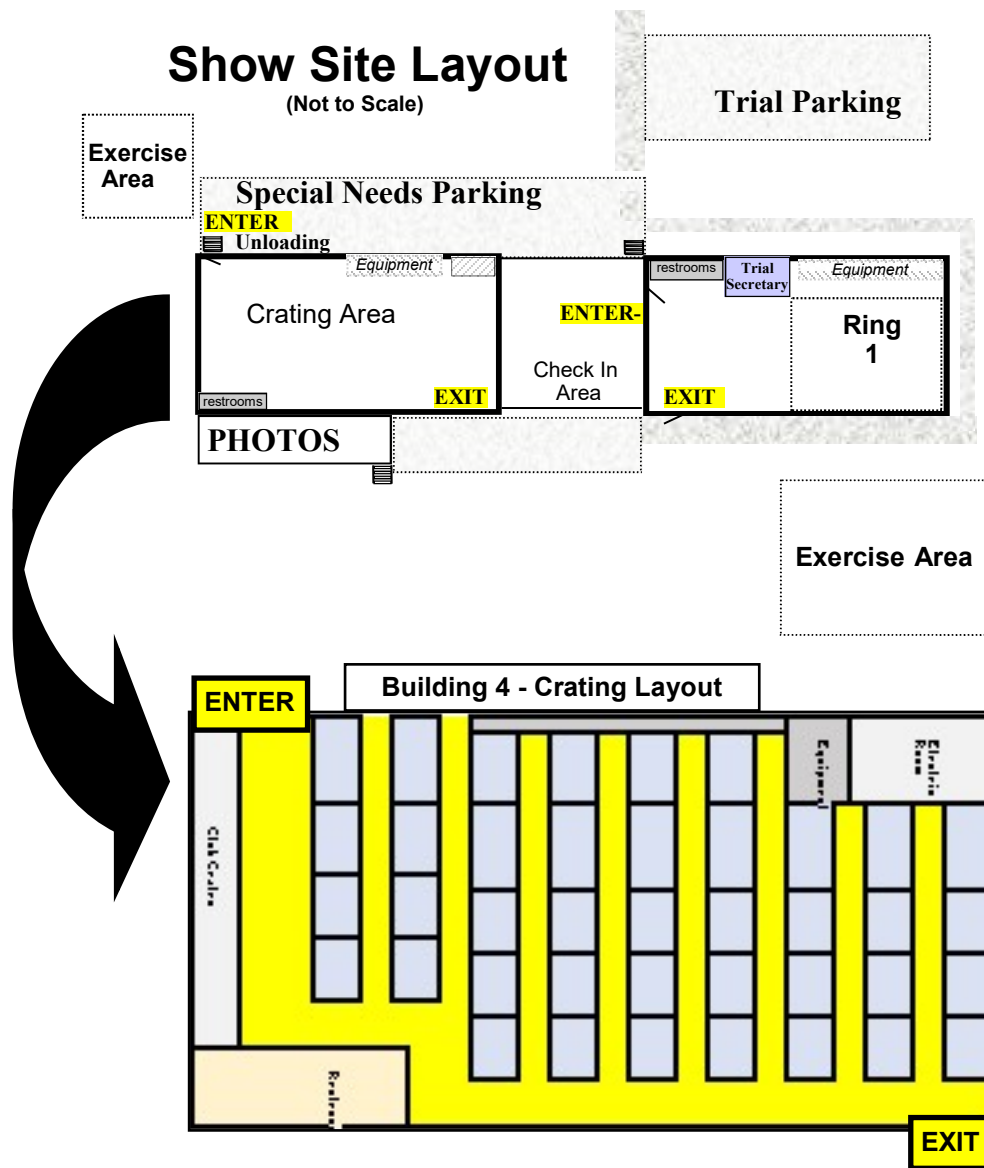
Judges may take a lunch break at their discretion.

***A Walkthrough will precede judging of the Rally and Beginner Novice classes.
The Preferred Novice and Novice A classes will also have a briefing scheduled before judging.**

Exhibitors:

Due to the Covid-19 restrictions, and in the interest of safety, we have made some adjustments to our trial procedures. Please read information below carefully. Your cooperation will make this work. Thank you!

- ★ **If you have recently been exposed to or have tested positive for Covid-19, don't feel well, have a fever, cough, or other symptoms of illness, please stay home. If your absence is related to Covid-19, your entry fees will be refunded.**
- ★ **Masks/face coverings must be properly worn covering both your nose and mouth in the Training Center, crating area and on the dock. For the safety of our judges and workers they must also be worn in the ring. Social distancing is a must.**
- ★ **The crating area (in building 4) will be marked with exhibitor areas - see crating layout and guidelines.**
- ★ **The field will also be available for outdoor crating, EZ ups for shade suggested. You may also choose to crate your dog in your car, weather permitting. Please do not leave dogs in hot cars.**
- ★ **We will be having self pick up for armbands. There will be an envelope on the dock with all of your armband stickers for the weekend plus course maps for each class you are entered in. Once you have your envelope, please check in with the gate person. You will have the same armband number for each trial, but you need to check in for all of your classes.**
- ★ **The Rally walk throughs will be split for the larger classes. Extra time has been included in the schedule, but your cooperation is appreciated. Those with multiple dogs in same class, one walk through only, please.**
- ★ **We will be limiting the number of exhibitors entering the trial building at a time. Our goal is to allow each exhibitor a few minutes to acclimate their dog to the building before they enter the ring. After your run, the judge will tell you if you have qualified. If you have qualified you may pick up your green qualifying ribbon at the trophy table. Please exit the building by the back door. Your Rally score will be posted on the dock. Please be courteous to our stewards.**
- ★ **No spectators in the trial building. A friend videoing your run is permitted.**
- ★ **Parking** next to the building is limited. You may unload near the building, then please move your vehicle. If you have special parking needs, please contact the Trial Secretary (LindestarGold@aol.com or 724-327-2411) for a reserved parking space. Even if you have an official Handicapped Parking permit, we need to know this to ensure that we have enough spaces reserved.
- ★ **Judges are not required to wait for any dogs. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs that are not required for further judging will be excused. **Please do not arrive more than 30 minutes before listed start time for your first class. When you are done for the day, please head home.** If you need assistance interpreting the schedule, please ask Trial Secretary: LindestarGold@aol.com or 724-244-3483**
- ★ **All Dogs** present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. Help keep our grounds neat—please use designated exercise areas & clean up after your dogs.
- ★ **Exhibitors** should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- ★ **Entry Fees Shall Not be Refunded** in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or a judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, hazardous weather or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show no refund of entries will be made. **If due to Covid-19 restrictions, WCOTC is forced to cancel these trials, checks will be shredded or full refunds will be made.**
- ★ **Bitches in Season** will not be admitted to the Trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season on the Trial date will be refunded the entry fee less \$5.00 (each entry) upon written certification by a veterinarian given to the Trial Secretary before the start of judging.
- ★ **Transfer/Move-up Policy: Obedience & Rally transfers/move-ups** to another class will be accepted as space permits within entry limits, in accordance with the Obedience & Rally Regulations. Requests for transfer must be made in writing and presented to the trial secretary **at least 30 minutes before the start of each trial**. **Earlier is Better!!** Forms may be downloaded from the AKC website at www.akc.org or requested from the Trial Secretary.

★ The crating area (in building 4) will be marked with limited exhibitor areas. Please arrange your seating so there is a crate and at least 6 feet between your chair and your neighbor's chair. The building occupancy is currently limited to 25 people at a time so please don't come too early and we ask that you leave the crating area when you are finished for the day. Setting up for social distancing is your responsibility, but if building is overcrowded, you may be asked to leave.

★ The field will also be available for outdoor crating, EZ ups for shade suggested. You may also choose to crate your dog in your car, weather permitting. Please do not leave dogs in hot cars.

★ **Parking** next to the building is limited. You may unload near the building, then please move your vehicle. If you have special parking needs, please contact the Trial Secretary (LindestarGold@aol.com or 724-327-2411) for a reserved parking space. Even if you have an official Handicapped Parking permit, we need to know this to ensure that we have enough spaces reserved.

Directions to WCOTC Training Center

From the West

Take PA Turnpike to Exit 57 (Monroeville.) After toll-booth take far right exit ramp towards Murrysville. Follow Route 22 East through Murrysville to intersection with Route 66 (10.4 miles.) Take Route 66 North exit ramp to Delmont.

***From the intersection of Rt. 22 and Rt. 66:

Continue north on Route 66 (2.9 miles) through two traffic lights, past Delmont Auto Sales and Valero's RV Sales. Just after you pass the Delmont Veterinary Hospital on the left, turn RIGHT into driveway for the Delmont North Industrial Park. Continue to the buildings at the top of the hill.

From the South or East

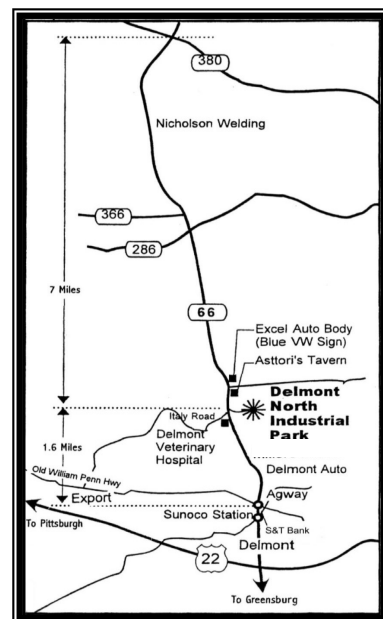
Take the PA Turnpike or Interstate 70 to the New Stanton interchange. Follow PA Toll Road 66 North to intersection with Route 22 (13.8 miles). Pass under Route 22 and follow directions from ***above.

From the North ***

Take Route 66 South. From the Route 380 intersection, continue 7 miles south. Past the blue VW sign for Excel Auto Body, turn left into Delmont North Industrial Park. Continue to the top of the hill.
