## VILLAGE OF MILLERTON Planning Board Meeting March 13, 2013

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The Village of Millerton Planning Board held its regular meeting on Wednesday, March 13, 2013 at 7:10 pm with Lance Middlebrook presiding. Planning Board Members present: Peter Greenough, Carol Gribble and Peter Richmond. Absent: Patti Lynch. Also present: Karen P. McLaughlin – Secretary.

## **Basil Gabriel's Project**

The board discussed Basil Gabriel's boarding house project. Although the board approved his project last month, the architect added the drawings of the garbage receptacle to the Site Plan and the short EAF needed to be completed.

 Motion made by Carol Gribble, seconded by Peter Richmond and all were in favor to declare the Planning Board lead agency. The board reviewed and went over the short EAF (see attached). Chair Middlebrook corrected the address on the EAF. Peter Greenough asked about item 9. Chair Middlebrook stated that the applicant misunderstood the question. The board identified Brad Rebellard's commercial business and cemetery as being adjacent properties.

The board discussed the definition of motel and discussed the proposed boarding tenant arrangement situation and agreed that it all met the zoning code. As Peter Richmond was absent from last month's meeting, the board caught him up on the discussions of the occupancy stipulations and signage. Peter Richmond expressed concern of the change in the current traffic pattern. Chair Middlebrook stated that even if all units were filled, the traffic pattern won't be changed. The board agreed there were no adverse changes proposed.

The board reviewed the SEQR questions and answered them as attached.

The board completed the short EAF addressing the SEQR questions and a motion was made by Peter Greenough, seconded by Peter Richmond and all were in favor to make a negative declaration. Chair Middlebrook stamped and signed the plans in its completion.

The board discussed the vacancy to be left by Patti Lynch and Peter Richmond, if elected to the village board. Chair Lance asked for the Board to think of possible candidates.
