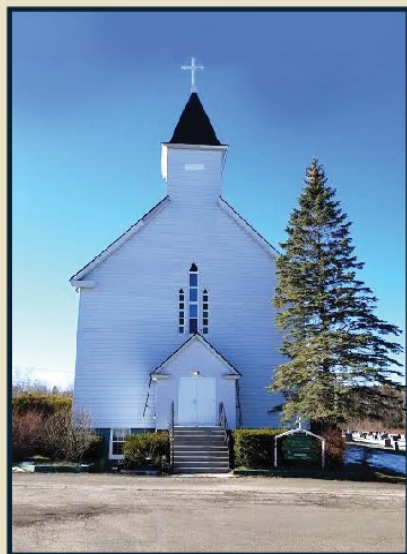
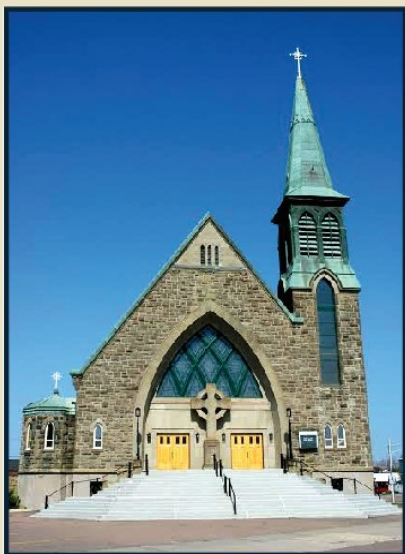

Justice, together with **peace**, calls us to change our attitudes and actions towards our environment. **Righteousness** calls for us to live in peace, not conflict, with our human

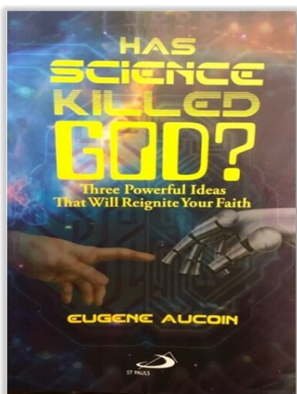
