

ORDINANCE NO. 289

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 20-8 AND 20-6 OF ORDINANCE NO. 277 PERTAINING TO THE PENALTY FOR ILLEGAL PARKING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLA, NORTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. That Section 20-8 of Ordinance No. 277 is hereby amended by adding Sub-section 5 thereto as follows:

"5. The penalty for the following types of illegal parking, to-wit: (1) Parking on the wrong side of the street; (2) Parking in front of a driveway; (3) Parking in front of a theater where curb is yellow; (4) Parking too close to a corner; (5) Parking too close to a hydrant; (6) Overtime parking; (7) Parking by curb painted yellow; (8) Parking on crosswalk; shall be \$ 3.00 for each offense, and in each such case the police officer may leave an appropriate notice of violation, with instructions, with the driver, or in the vehicle, or tied to the drivers door handle, allowing the violator to pay such fine without appearing in court; the police officer shall keep a copy of the record of the vehicle license and other identifying data, to turn over to the City Judge, and if the fine is not paid within five days, further proceedings according to law may be instituted by the City, its police officers and officials, against the owner of the vehicle."

Section 2. That Section 20-6 of Ordinance No. 277 is hereby amended by adding Sub-section (a) thereto as follows:

"Section 20-6(a) Any person who fails to pay a fine for illegal parking within five days after his vehicle is lawfully ticketed for illegal parking, is guilty of an offense, for which the maximum penalty shall be 30 days in jail or a \$100.00 fine or both such fine and imprisonment."

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect and take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication.
