Showtime Camping Rules

New gate entrance for all campers!

Prior to showtime, all camping traffic enters through <u>GATE A</u> on Cox Road.

** During show hours of 8am to 5pm,
All camping traffic will enter and exit through
GATE D on County Hwy M **

Anyone trying to enter the campground through <u>Gate A</u> will be sent to <u>Gate D</u> during showtime.

- 1. All campsites on R.R.T. Grounds are considered "primitive" campsites. 2. Connections to water or electricity are strictly prohibited.
- 3. Camping Fees are as follows:
 - a. \$75.00 for the Annual Reunion held over Labor Day Weekend.
 - b. \$10.00 per Adult per day for daily gate admission (13 years old and up) c. Children 12 and under are free

4. Dog(s):

- a. No dogs are allowed on the grounds except for medical purposes.
- b. No Dogs in the campground except for medical purposes.
- c. Dogs will be allowed during the 4 days of the Annual RRT Reunion; during this time all dogs must be leashed and remain within your campsite.
 - i. No walking thru campground or showgrounds proper. Any violators will be asked to leave.
 - ii. Excessive barking will not be tolerated. If excessive barking becomes an issue you will be asked to remove the dog from RRT grounds immediately.
- 5. Minors may not camp without adult supervision. Parents/Guardians will be held responsible for their children's actions.
- 6. Curfew will be 10pm for all children 17 years old and younger. Must be back to the campsite by

10pm.

- 7. Camping is permitted only in designated areas:
 - a. From May 1st to October 31st, NO Camping outside the perimeter of the train tracks. You must remain within the designated camping area.
 - b. Camping will be allowed outside the perimeter of the train tracks during show time (from Friday of pull out weekend thru the Monday after put away weekend).
- 8. All persons wishing to camp on the Thresheree grounds must register with the Camping Manager prior to setting up.
- 9. Camping registration tags must be displayed in the 1st window to the left of the door on rv and on tent units the tag must be displayed on the door (in e.x. Zip tied to the zipper). 10. Only 2 vehicles per campsite are permitted.
- 11. The posted speed limit is <u>5MPH</u>.
- 12. No parking in Fire lanes. Vehicles parked in fire lanes will be towed at the owner's expense.
- 13. Trailers and exhibits:
 - a. Trailers other than camping units cannot be parked in campgrounds. Must be either taken home or parked in approved trailer parking.
 - b. Exhibits are not to be parked or stored in campgrounds; this includes tractors, trailers, small engines and any other display.
- 14. Garbage must be placed in the provided container. You must clean up your campsite and leave it as you found it.
- 15. Campfires are allowed; however, you must have a fire ring or dig a hole and fill it in when you leave your campsite. Fires shall not be left unattended.
- 16. Generators
 - a. Generators must maintain a decibel rating of less than 75 at 15 feet.
 - b. Generators may run from 6AM to 10PM and MUST be shut OFF between 10PM and 6AM
- 17. The campground gate within showgrounds will be closed to vehicles between 8AM and 5PM. daily during any R.R.T. event.
- 18. Guests must pay admission into the park each day.
- 19. No long term camping. The maximum consecutive time is 2 weeks. (adopted 2019)

** Please be RESPECTFUL Don't walk through other campsites!**
