Dear High School Band Student(s) & Parents/Guardians:

Hello & Happy Summer! Hope you're having tons of fun & staying cool. This letter has important detailed information, regarding band camp, marching shoe order (response needed by Aug 2nd), fund raising & Music Association information.

MARCHING BAND & COLOR GUARD SHOES

Please find and try on your band shoes. If you can't find them or they don't fit, you need to put in an order today so the shoes will be there for you on the first day of band camp. Don't forget your first performance is the Labor Day Parade (Sept. 4th) and the Drillmaster marching shows are part of your uniform. The shoes will be fitted the first day of band camp which will give us time to reorder if we need to exchange sizes. **Students need to bring or wear a pair of socks on the first day of band camp to try on the shoes.**
NOTE: YOUR CURRENT SHOES NEED TO BE CLEAN, FREE OF MUD AND GRIME – CLEAN THEM!

If you need to order shoes please fill out the enclosed card and send it back with a check in the amount of \$36.00 made out to the MPS Music Association on or before August 2nd. Please do not wait – order will be placed on August 7th. Please mail to: Marlene Manell, 239 Wilson Street, Marlborough, MA 01752. If you feel purchasing the marching shoes will be a financial hardship, please advise either Mr. Piazza or Marlene Manell as soon as possible.

Sizes available:

Women's	Men's
5 to 12 ½ medium width only (whole and half sizes) 13 to 18 medium or wide (whole sizes only)	3-10 ½ medium width only (whole and half sizes) 11-16 medium or wide (whole sizes only)

Note: When sizing these marching band shoes, it is suggested to use students' dress shoe size, not sneaker size.

Band Camp takes place at Marlborough High School Monday through Friday, August 21 – 25, 2017, from 9 am until 3 pm daily. Students should bring a bag lunch Monday through Thursday, a water bottle, and sun screen. They will be both inside learning music and outside learning the show. They should wear appropriate length shorts, t-shirts or tank tops and sneakers to be comfortable walking and playing their instruments inside and out. Mr. Piazza, Band Director, will be sending out a letter with more information about band camp within a few weeks.

On Friday afternoon of band camp, the MPS Music Association provides a cookout at a marching band student's home as a thank you for all their hard work they have done for the week. We would like a few parent volunteers who are available to help with the set up and cleanup of this cookout. The location will be announced during band camp. WIND ENSEMBLE, STRING ENSEMBLE AND A CAPPELLA CHOIR PERFORMANCE ATTIRE

Marching Band Members who are in Wind, String and A cappella Choir, will be fitted for your concert performance attire (music department issued tuxedos or long dresses) during band camp. **For Dress Fittings- you MUST bring your dress shoes that you will be performing in to band camp for the dress fitting.** Shoe heels are to be 2" high or less. Flats are fine too. The dresses will be hemmed according to the height of shoes you bring in. Please refer to the Required Performance Attire Sheet enclosed for more information.

CONCERT BAND PERFORMANCE ATTIRE

Students will supply their own performance attire. The performance attire will consist of:

Black collared, long sleeved, button-down dress shirt. No trim or ruffles. The shirt/blouse will be tucked in.

Black slacks. No Leggings, jeans, or other casual pants. Black socks or stockings/nylons and black dress shoes. Heels 2" or less. Men:

Solid black tie

♪ --Please note that the black Drillmaster marching shoes are acceptable to wear during the concert season.—

CONCERT ATTIRE MUST BE BROUGHT IN ON MONDAY OR TUESDAY OF BAND CAMP - TO BE CHECKED FOR APPROPRIATENESS WITH EITHER MRS. MANELL OR MRS. WOOD. If you feel purchasing this attire is a financial hardship, please advise either Mr. Piazza or Marlene Manell as soon as possible.

JAZZ ENSEMBLE PERFORMANCE ATTIRE

For those of you **NEW** to the Jazz Ensemble, please bring your black pants to school for approval. **(Please note form fitting pants, stretch pants, leggings & similar garments Are Not Acceptable).** Concert Band black pants are acceptable.

You will be fitted with a black shirt. And will be told where to sew six buttons into the waist band to accommodate suspenders. Buttons are not provided – ½ to ¾” diameter suit buttons will work fine.

FOOTBALL GAME RESERVED SEATS

To the parents/friends who would like to sit in the stands with other music parents during football games. Reserved seats in the stadium will be enforced. You are encouraged to purchase a season ticket. The cost will be approximately \$30 for a season ticket for all home games. It is suggested that you obtain your season ticket as soon as tickets go on sale. Sale dates for tickets will be posted on the MHS and MHS Athletic website. MUSIC FESTIVALS (MUSIC COMPETITIONS)

Each year the HS performing music groups participate in various In-State Music Festivals (i.e., MAJE & MICCA). Once every two years, with the approval of the administration, Superintendent and School Committee, they have participated in an out-of-state Music Festival and have previously performed in Orlando, Virginia Beach, Williamsburg & Toronto.

Even though there is no out-of-state music festival trip for this school year 2017/18, we still urge you to participate in as many student fund raising opportunities to help offset the cost of any out-of-state music festival trip.

FUND RAISING OPPORTUNITIES

There are many fund raising opportunities throughout the year available to your student. Students can build student credit which accumulates throughout their years in the music program in their individual accounts. This credit will help offset costs of out-of-state Music Festival trips & other approved music related needs. Please take advantage of all fund raising opportunities to help build student credit and offset out-of-state trip costs. Dates of fund raising opportunities will be posted in the fall.

Please note the State regulations regarding candy sales will be enforced at MHS. STUDENTS WILL NO LONGER BE ALLOWED TO SELL CANDY DURING THE SCHOOL DAY. CANDY WILL ONLY BE AVAILABLE THROUGH MRS. KINSLOW. For those of you who would like to sell candy bars at your work or to friends and relatives during the summer & the school year, candy bars are available. Please call Mrs. Ann Kinslow at 508-491-6103 to make arrangements to pick up the candy at her house. Student credit is 50% of each candy bar sold. One box costs \$40 for 40 candy bars. Students will receive \$20 credit for each box purchased.
