We will participate in two activities in the area which will be decided by weather and time before the planned day.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Beaumont Botanical Gardens are a portion of the 500-acre Tyrell Park which is listed on the Great Texas Coastal Birding Trail map. • Cattail Marsh Scenic Wetlands & Boardwalk includes 900-acres of scenic wetlands along with a boardwalk and covered platforms that provide views of the abundant wildlife. visitors can spot alligators sunbathing along the banks of Hillebrandt Bayou and Willow Marsh Bayou within <u>Cattail Marsh</u>. • Big Thicket Nature Preserve is a heavily forested area in SE Texas and a nature lovers paradise <p>A van provided by the United Methodist Church will be used with a departure time of 7:00 AM and a planned return time between the hours of 6 and 8 PM. The mileage from the UMC to Beaumont is about 110 miles with a travel time of 2+ hours. A stop at Buc-ees on our way to Beaumont and an early to mid-afternoon lunch stop is being planned.</p>
