
Happy Lord's Day!

Last week I wrote a little bit about the life of Blessed Carlo Acutis, who will soon be canonized (sometime in 2025, I think). He had a great passion for the Eucharist, as all Catholic-Christians ought to have. How could we not get caught in amazement at the reality of Jesus' presence among us and inside of us? I mentioned that he had a very particular passion for sharing about miraculous moments in history when something additionally supernatural occurred with the Eucharist, either during Mass or outside of Mass. These are typically referred to as "Eucharistic Miracles" and have been present throughout different times in Church history.

As a bit of a review, what takes place at Mass each and every time the Mass is offered validly by a Catholic priest or bishop is truly miraculous. Bread and wine are placed on the altar while the priest prays the appropriate prayers. When he says the Words of Institution from the Last Supper - "Take this, all of you, and eat of it, for this is my Body which will be given up for you. ... Take this, all of you, and drink from it, for this is the chalice of my Blood, the blood of the new and eternal covenant, which will be poured out for you and for many. Do this in memory of me." - the bread and wine totally change into the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ. The word we use to describe this change is transubstantiation. Even though the Eucharist still looks, smells, tastes, and feels like bread and wine, there is no longer any bread and wine on the altar (more specifically, on the white cloth (aka the corporal) on the altar). Four of our five senses are deceived, but it is hearing alone that understands the reality before us when we hear those words from Jesus through the mouth of the priest. This, all by itself, is a true Eucharistic Miracle! Without the gift of faith, it is unbelievable. With the gift of faith, it is transformational. With or without your personal faith, Jesus Christ does in fact become present to us during Holy Mass and remains with us when the Eucharist is placed in the tabernacle at the end of Communion time during Mass. What a gift!

All of that being said, there have been several times (more than a hundred!) throughout Christian history when an additional miracle has taken place regarding the Eucharist. This is what is most often meant when a person refers to a Eucharistic Miracle and this was one of Blessed Carlo's main passions. He researched each miracle and created a website to help others learn about them and come to a deeper belief in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. The website is: miracolieucharistici.org and then there is an option for English that you can click. What happens with the Eucharistic Miracles? With some, the appearance of the bread and wine changed as it was changed into the Body and Blood of the Lord, to appear as real flesh and real blood. With others, the Eucharistic hosts were miraculously preserved for decades of years without the least corruption to the elements. For others, people would try to do evil actions with the Eucharist (such as stealing the Host and throwing it in the fire, etc) only for the Eucharist to start floating out of reach or radiating with bright light. Others, including priests, would doubt the truth of the doctrine, and the host started to drip with blood as it was consecrated. In other words, the Lord performs an extra miracle for the sake of leading people to deeper belief and quenching their doubts. Not all who doubt are given the gift of seeing a double-miracle - this is part of the mystery of God's miracles - but we are all given the gift of being able to read about them, at least in part thanks to Blessed Carlo. Next week we'll actually start to get some examples.
