Any birds that become sick must be removed from the grounds upon request of the show manager or designated authority. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of show superintendent or department managers.

Bring birds prepaid to Show Manager, Hamilton County fairgrounds Cincinnati, OH no later than 9 PM Tuesday, August 9, 2014. Birds will be released at 8:00 PM Sunday, August 14, 2014. The Hamilton County fair, employees, show managers, volunteers and the Hamilton County Agricultural Society will not be held liable for loss by fire, sickness, accident, theft or damage of any kind.

All exhibits will be tagged with name of Breed and Exhibitors' demographic information. Exhibition birds will be judged according to the American Standard of Perfection. Premiums will be paid on single birds according to breed and variety. The exhibitor must be the owner of the exhibit. No unworthy specimen will receive premiums whether there is competition or not. Show champions will be selected from this class.

Trophies will be awarded to Champion Large & Reserve Large Fowl, Champion and Reserve Bantam, Champion Turkey, Champion Waterfowl, Champion Pigeon, Champion Other Recognized Fowl. To qualify for trophy awards, entries must be received by July 21, 2016. Rosettes will be awarded to Cutest City Chicken, Champion Meet/Production Poultry and Ugliest Chicken.

Pullorum testing will be available upon request. The Hamilton County Poultry Department will provide feed for livestock and will feed and water daily. Specialty feeds must be supplied by the exhibitor.

Youth show will operate with the same rules and regulations as the adult division. The youth show is open to any exhibitor under 18 years of age upon the commencement of the fair. This does not substitute for 4H or FFA events and is open to all youth who want to participate.
