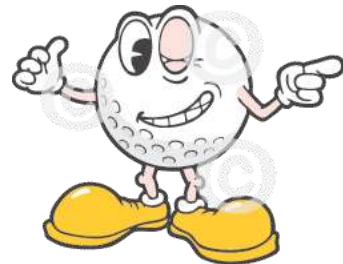
Just to get onto your social calendar for 2017 –
