Variations on all Basic Stitches

#### **ADVANCED**

Bullions (over 60 wraps)
Cast-on (over 60 casts)
Technical Innovations, Combinations & Specialty Stitches

# **B.D.E.I.G. CLASS INTENSITY**

## **LOW INTENSITY**

Students will have time in class to practice all techniques/stitches taught. Class will be relaxing and informative.

### **MEDIUM INTENSITY**

Average students will have time to try the techniques/stitches taught. Class material will be covered quickly and thoroughly at a medium pace.

#### **HIGH INTENSITY**

Class will be fast-paced with LOTS of information/stitching/techniques. Students who work at a slower pace could have difficulty.
