BED RACE RULES

1. Teams must register online by **JUNE 29, 2017**. See **ONLINE PAYMENT** below for instructions.
2. Team registration is \$100. All proceeds go toward the NOTL Legacy Project: Upper Canada Heritage Trail.
3. Race starts at 6:30 p.m. sharp.
4. Winning team(s) will be called to stage to accept their prizes. One or more team members must be present in order to win.
5. Each team should consist of 5 people = 4 runners + 1 rider (1 alternate is optional)
6. Participant riding the bed must wear a helmet.
7. Beds should be decorated in order to qualify for prizes and should look like a bed (design must incorporate “mattress”, “headboard” and “footboard”).
8. Canada or Canada 150 themes are encouraged for bed and team costumes. Other designs will be accepted. (Please note: this is a family event.)
9. The Race has 2 parts: a. Two teams will race together per heat to determine the best times. b. Teams with the best times will race in pairs to determine the winning team.
10. All 5 team members must pass finish line (with the bed) in order to win.
11. Prizes appropriate to the Canada 150 theme will be awarded in the following categories:
 - a. Fastest time
 - b. Most innovative design and costumes

ONLINE PAYMENT ONLY - \$100 per team:

1. Go to <http://notl.maxgalaxy.net/Home.aspx> and click on “Create Account”.
2. Click “Click here to Register for an Activity”
3. In Search Activities window, enter bed and click “Go”.
4. Click on green Register button next to Bed Race, enter information, then Add to Cart.
5. Enter your credit card details, click on “Pay Now”.
6. You will receive a confirmation email and receipt. Please bring your receipt to the event.

BED CONFIGURATION

1. Maximum size is twin size bed
2. The bed must include a mattress or padding, a headboard and a footboard.
3. Beds must have minimum of four wheels (one in each corner), all wheels must touch the ground, wheels can be any size.
4. Beds and race criteria
 - a. Any size wheels are permitted, four wheels minimum, one in each corner.
 - b. No braking devices allowed.
 - c. No steering devices or mechanical means of propulsion.
 - d. May have push bars under 4 inches out.

- e. No sharp objects should jut out. No breakable or offensive objects are allowed.
 - f. Beds should be pushed not pulled.
5. Eligible entries will be at the judges' discretion.
