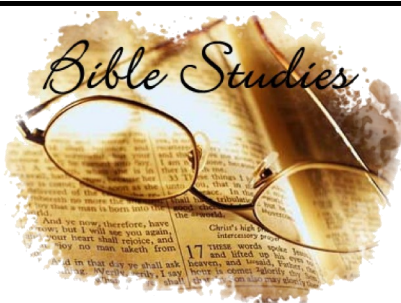
## Book of Remembrance
