The regular meeting was called to order on Tuesday, April 10, 2018 at 7:00 P.M. by Township Supervisor Allan with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call found present: Brandon Royer, Derrick Cox, Michael Foley, Dan Hopkins and Supervisor Allan.

A motion to approve the minutes of the meeting held Tuesday, March 27, 2018 was made by Trustee Foley and seconded by Trustee Cox. Roll Call found 4 ayes. Motion carried.

Supervisor Allan asked for any comments from the public. Don Cox said someone in the Annual Meeting stated that there had been lies spoken, and if so he wants to know what they are. He was advised that we could not discuss the previous meeting without suspending Roberts Rules of Order. A motion was made by Trustee Cox to suspend Roberts Rules. Motion seconded by Trustee Hopkins... Motion carried unanimously. Trustee Hopkins then addressed the question from Mr. Cox, stating he wasn't going to point any fingers at other trustees and that is why he had requested folks call him or see him after the meeting. Jim Stack then replied to the question saying that lowering taxes vs lowering levies is 2 different things. Just because you lower a levy doesn't mean your taxes will go down. Trustee Cox corrected his remark to lowered levy instead of taxes.

Larry Gulledege asked the Township Board to support the dissolution of C.A.R.D. by passing a resolution of support. He stated the cities of Collinsville, Glen Carbon, Maryville and Unit 10 have already passed resolutions and Pontoon Beach is considering.

A motion was made by Trustee Hopkins and seconded by Trustee Foley to re-instate Roberts Rules of Order. Motion carried.

The General Assistance bills for \$4,762.68 were read. A motion to approve the bills as read was made by Trustee Foley and seconded by Trustee Royer. Roll Call found all ayes (4). Motion carried.

The Road and Bridge bills for \$58,011.84 were read. A motion to approve the bills as read was made by Trustee Hopkins and seconded by Trustee Foley. Roll Call found all ayes (5).

The Town fund Bills for \$33,032.22 were read. A motion to approve the bills was made by Trustee Foley and seconded by Trustee Hopkins. Roll call found all ayes (5) on the motion. Motion carried. There was a discussion prior to voting on the Town Fund about the balance. deposits, etc.

Correspondence was read by Clerk Dowling. Trustee Cox requests she put on next agenda to discuss ways to approve donations.

Under old business the trustees suggests Supervisor Allan get the price from the owner of the lot next door to the Senior Center in writing for next meeting. Packets from AAIC were passed out to all Trustees with the breakdown of estimated costs for the work that has been requested at the Senior Center.

Road Commissioner Trucano reported he has ordered a new truck from International Harvester and will be selling an old truck.

There being no further business to come before the Board motion by Trustee Foley and seconded by Trustee Hopkins Motion carried.
