Beeton Creek and Tottenham Pond



Beeton Creek

Tottenham Conservation Area offers something for everyone - wetlands, pond, fishing, beach, swimming, open fields, campsites, picnic areas, beautiful trees, natural grass areas, and heavy bush. It is ideal for naturalists and photographers.

The park is also a wonderful location in the winter for cross country skiing, walking, and tobogganing.

Tottenham C.A. is also home of the Tottenham Bluegrass Festival held annually at the end of June.

POINTS OF INTEREST

1. From Mill Street, turn left onto track.
2. Beach and swimming area.
3. Join vehicle track.
4. Enter forest and follow twist and turns of trail.
5. Follow trail to the right.
6. Leave forest for open grassland, follow tree line while climbing hill.
7. View across to Tottenham Road.
8. Through a small pine forest area.
9. Cross over Mill Street to start north trail.
10. Small hill.
11. Turn left and follow track. Watch for trail turning right halfway up hill.
12. Sharp left turn, steps up steep hill.
13. Descend hill back to Beeton Creek.
14. Boardwalk through marsh.
15. Left turn to bridge over Beeton Creek.
16. Sharp right turn to follow Beeton Creek - Trail may be wet.

VISTA POINTS

1. Beaver dam.
2. Bridge over Beeton Creek
3. Steam Railway.
4. View towards Tottenham Pond.

Note: Northern loop of the trail (#12 and #13) is closed until further notice, due to flooding as a result of beaver activity.
