"Trusting God in Times of Crises"

"God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam and the mountains quake with their surging. There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the holy place where the Most High dwells. God is within her, she will not fall; God will help her at break of day. Nations are in uproar. kingdoms fall; he lifts his voice, the earth melts. The Lord Almighty is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress." Psalm 46: 1-7

First of all the psalmist reminds us that God is our REFUGE.

Psalm 91:4 where it says,

"God will shield you with His wings."

<u>Psalm 9:9</u> promises, "The Lord will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble."

The second thing this Psalm says we can know about God is that.... He is our STRENGTH.

Psalm 27:1 says, "The Lord is my light and my salvation
Whom shall I Fear? The Lord is the strength of my life...of whom shall I be afraid?"
Philippians 4:13 Paul said, "I can do all things-I can face any crises-through Him Who gives me strength."

Paul in 2 Corinthians 12: 10-11, "Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. That is why for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties for when I am weak, then I am strong."

Also we know that even in the midst of crisis, He is WITH US.

In his book, The God You Are Looking For, Bill Hybels points out that we are relational beings. God created us to require companionship. God meets our inborn need for constant companionship because He is always with us. In Hebrews 13:5 God promises, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."

Remember-as this Psalmist reminds us, no crisis is too big for God. The earth could give way-the mountains could fall into the sea-and even that would not cause us fear-because God is with us. Our omnipotent God is an "ever-present help."

In his book, Reaching For The Invisible God, Philip Yancey points out that when it comes down to it, when crisis comes we have two choices: Believe the crisis is bigger than God or that God is bigger than the crisis.
