Examples by Location:

Alaska: Trout, Ling Cod, Rock Fish, Halibut, Salmon

Bahamas and Mexico: Barracuda, Largemouth Bass

Brazil: Peacock Bass

Florida: Deep Sea, Shallows, Peacock Bass, Largemouth Bass

Kentucky: White Bass, Stripers

Louisiana: Speckled trout, Redfish and Flounder are the most common inshore species targeted, but plenty of other fish species are abundant as well. Black drum, White Trout, Tripletail, Cobia, Spanish and King Mackerel, Snapper, Pompano and Sharks can be found along the Southwest Louisiana coastline and near shore oil platforms.

Maryland: Rockfish, Bluefish, Croaker, Black Drum, White Perch

Trout:

- Brook Trout in 9 locations throughout Canada and the USA.
- Brown Trout in 15 locations in the US, and one in New Zealand.
- Cutthroat Trout – over a dozen locations.
- Rainbow Trout – over a dozen locations.
- Speckled Trout – Louisiana, Texas

Marlin, Dorado: Mexico, Bahamas, Panama, Costa Rica, Guatemala, Florida

Largemouth Bass: Mexico, Missouri, Alabama, Texas, South Carolina, Florida

Northern Pike – Over 15 locations in US and Canada

Permit – Bahamas, Florida, Belize, Mexico

Redfish – Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, South Carolina, Texas

Rooster Fish – Mexico, Costa Rica, Panama

Sailfish – Bahamas, Mexico, Panama, Costa Rica, Guatemala, Florida

Smallmouth Bass – Minnesota, Ohio, Manitoba, Ontario, New Brunswick, South Dakota, Oklahoma, Ontario
