Coverage Spotlight: Boat Theft - Is it covered?

Most dealerpolicies provide zero physical damage coverage for boats and watercrafts. A typical dealer policy covers automobiles which are defined in the policy as "land motor vehicles, trailers, or semitrailers." Since a boat orwatercraft is not an "auto" there is no coverage in case of theft or othermishap on the lot.

To remedy thisphysical damage gap in coverage all of DMI's dealer policies automatically include for no premium charge a limited watercraft endorsement. The endorsementitself replaces the definition of an auto in the dealer policy to read: "Auto" means a land motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or watercraft up to 26 feet in length but only while ashore on premises where you conduct "garageoperations."
