#### A NOTE FROM PASTOR JIM

Dear Friends in Christ.

The Apostle John writes, "If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (1 John 1: 8-9)

Martin Luther comments on these words. "The message of the forgiveness of sins only applies to true Christians who honestly acknowledge their sins and also are affected by them. The other coarse people who neither acknowledge their sins nor feel anything about them understand nothing about this article of faith. However, the true Christians who are sincerely afflicted by their sins can at least be consoled by their belief in the forgiveness of sins. For they have been baptized, they hear the Gospel and receive absolution and the holy sacrament. For God has placed this treasure, the forgiveness of sins into His Word and this sacrament and has decreed that they should be believed."

As we move forward into March we continue to be in the season of Lent, journeying along with Jesus on His way to Jerusalem. He had a single purpose in this journey, to offer Himself as a sacrifice for the sins of all people and in doing so, to spare them eternal punishment which they would deserve, and instead, offer eternal life for all who will believe that He is the Messiah, the Savior who the prophets of the Old Testament saw and prophesied.

May each of our Lenten journeys involve an honest assessment of our lives as we consider of our sins, but also, a let us be ever thankful for what Jesus has accomplished for us, knowing that He lives and reigns with the Father and the Holy Spirit, now and forever. Amen.
