

Rules and General Information

- Entrants under 19 years of age need to have a parent's or legal guardian's signature on their entry form.
- Riders need HCBC membership to bring horses to Cedar Vista Stables
- Entries close 1 week prior to the horse show. Post entries will be accepted as long as space permits.
- All riders need to be accompanied by a trainer or person responsible.
- Each horse/rider combination need to have their own entry # in order to compete in a class
- Equine Canada rules are to be followed as a guideline, and Equine Canada Drug rules apply.
- Non-competitor rounds are allowed once that horse and rider are finished competition for the day.
- Horses may enter a class more than once with a different rider.
- Horse/Rider combinations may only move up or down one level at the same show and may choose different levels at other shows.
- Grass reins are permitted in the trot pole class.
- NO cost for lead line class.
- Limited warm up time is available before each division. Please contact show organizers for warm up days available prior to the show if needed.
- A limited concession will be provided on the grounds
- DRESS: should be neat with fitted clothing (not loose) or a riding jacket. Proper riding boots with a heel or paddock boots and half chaps in good repair.
- All riders MUST wear ASTM approved helmets while mounted
- **PRIZES:** Each show will have Championship and Reserve Championship for all divisions. Prizes will be given for first place.
- **EQUITATION SERIES** – Hunter and Jumper medal classes are qualifiers at the first 4 horse shows....the final horse show will have the top 12 riders in each section 2'0"/2'3" and 2'6"/2'9" ride in the final hunter and jumper medal classes with a ride off of the top 3 riders in each section the last day. 2'0"/2'3" winner will be awarded a custom tack box and 2'6"/2'9" winner will be awarded a Antares Spooner saddle.
- **POINTS** will be accumulated at each show and follow "the rider" for year-end awards:
 - 1st 7 points
 - 2nd 5 points
 - 3rd 4 points
 - 4th 3 points
 - 5th 2 points
 - 6th 1 point

****MEDAL CLASSES** = Not part of the division points, Riders may only enter one height section of the medal classes and it is not open to riders that have shown higher than 1.10m or higher in the last 5 years. 2'6" and lower not open to riders who have shown over 3'0" in the last 10 years. Points from both the hunter and jumper medals count towards the final points. Ride off at the last horse show.
