Summer 2017 Guidelines

Spaces are limited and priority will be given to children who are enrolled at MA for the 2017-2018 school year during Early Bird Registration (March 3 - 24). Children placed on the waiting list will be notified on March 27th about available spaces. All completed forms must be returned by Monday, April 17th to ensure placement.
