Rules & Regulations

1. Entrants under 19 years of age need to have a parent's or legal guardian's signature on entry form.
2. Shows are sanctioned by Horse Council BC and governed by the current Horse Council BC Rule Book.
3. Riders must be current Horse Council BC members to bring horses to Cedar Vista Stables.
4. All riders need to be accompanied by a trainer or person responsible.
5. Each horse/rider combination need to have their own entry # in order to compete in a class.
6. Hors concours entries are not permitted.
7. Horses may enter a class more than once with a different rider.
8. All riders **MUST** wear ASTM approved helmets while mounted.
9. All tests will be ridden in a 20 x 60 ring.
10. Gate at A will remain open at all times for all competitors.
11. Callers are allowed in all tests. Competitors must provide their own callers who must be dressed appropriately.
12. No headsets will be permitted.
13. Braiding is optional.
14. Boots and leg wraps on horses is optional.
15. Classical or casual informal riding attire is permitted.
16. Current Equine Canada/USEF/HCBC/FEI dressage tests will be used as requested on the entry form. (HCBC tests 2010, EC/USEF tests 2019)

Entries

1. Entries open Sunday, September 27, 2020.
2. Entries must be received by Sunday, October 4th, 2020 at end of day.
3. Each test is \$40.00.
4. Please use one entry form for each horse and athlete combination with separate cheques for each individual entry.
5. Only completed, legible entries that include all photocopies and a signed, dated waiver will be accepted. Entries not including copies of required membership cards will be subject to a \$25.00 incomplete entry fee.
6. All entries must include a photocopy of a current HCBC membership for both athlete and horse owner.
7. Entries can be emailed to cedarvista@shaw.ca. No hand-delivered entries will be accepted. If the show is over-subscribed, the email-received date will be used to determine one's position on the wait list.
8. Corrections on entries and monies owing must be cleared up before entries close or entry will be void.
9. Please make cheques payable to Cedar Vista Stables. Payment can also be made by e-transfer to cedarvista@shaw.ca. Password must be "dressage".
10. Entries received prior to the received date, but after the competition is full, will be put on a waiting list. They will not be subject to late fees if they are accepted into the show. If the competitor does not wish to be on a wait list or does not get into the show, all entry fees will be refunded.
11. Before the entry deadline, changes to entries are accepted at the discretion of the entry secretary and subject to a \$25 office fee.
12. After the entry deadline no changes to classes will be made.
13. After the entry deadline, horse/pony and athlete substitutions may only be made in the event of illness or injury with a Veterinarian or Physician certificate, providing that the class, test & category remain the same. These changes are subject to a \$25 office fee. Once a horse/pony or athlete has withdrawn from the show, for any reason, these substitutions can no longer be made. Substitutions must be made at time of withdrawal. A certificate must be presented by Monday October 12th, 2020. You cannot substitute both the horse and athlete in the same entry.

Class Rules

1. Classes may be scheduled at any time on the day listed on the class schedule.
2. Riders may choose to ride Equine Canada or Horse Council BC tests.
3. Limit 2 tests per rider/horse combination.
4. Ride times may be rescheduled at any time due to scratches, errors, overlapping times, unforeseen conflicts, or to facilitate the running of the show.
5. In the event that there are less than four entries in any athlete category (Jr/Am or Open), the Show Committee reserves the right to combine athlete categories within classes, where permitted.
6. Ties will be broken by the collective marks. Ties remaining after collective marks will stay tied.

Refunds

1. Prior to the show closing date, all fees will be refunded, less the administration fee.
2. After the closing date, class and stabling fees will be refunded with a Veterinarian's or Physician's certificate, administration fees will not be refunded. A certificate must be presented to the entry secretary no later than October 12th, 2020 for any fees to be refunded.

Awards

Prizes awarded to 3rd place. Rosettes awarded to 6th place. Rosettes can be picked up with the tests after the class is completed.

When there is only one horse in a class, ribbons shall be awarded in accordance with the following chart of percentages: No ribbons shall be awarded below 4th position.

1st 60% or higher

2nd ... 57% to 59.9%

3rd 54% to 56.9%

4th 51% to 53.9%

Single scores of less than 50% will not count toward any awards, ribbons.

In the event of a tie, the horse/pony/athlete with the highest total collective marks shall be declared the winner.

If the tie is unbreakable, the horse/pony/athlete shall remain tied.

Champion and Reserve Champions will be established by totalling the two highest percentages of a horse/pony/athlete combination in each division and athlete category. The competitor with the highest total will be named champion. The competitor with the second highest total will be named reserve champion.

Division Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded according to the following schedule:

(Please note: Junior/Amateur will be split if entries warrant, divisions may be combined depending on entries)
