Minutes of November 15, 2021

The Huntington Township Trustees met in regular scheduled session at 7:00 PM at the Township Hall. Meeting called to order with the pledge of Allegiance by Robert Holmes. Also present were Walter Rollin, Jed Lamb, Matt Combs, Dennis Finkel, Deputy Joe Sprouse, Deputy Dylan Hazzard and Sheila Lanning. *Motion* by Lamb with a second by Rollin to approve the minutes of the regular scheduled meeting of November 1, 2021 as written. Roll call: three yeas. Checks 9729-9742 and payments totaling \$19,699.27 approved for payment. *Motion* by Lamb with a second by Rollin to approve *Resolution 2021-52* adopting an IT Disaster Recovery Plan as recommended by Auditor of State. Roll call: three yeas. *Motion* by Holmes with a second by Lamb to approve *Resolution 2021-53* adopting a Fuel Usage and Card Policy as recommended by Auditor of State. Roll call: three yeas. *Motion* by Lamb with a second by Rollin to approve *Resolution 2021-54* authorizing the Technical Rescue contract renewal for three years beginning 1/1/2022 and ending 12/31/2024. Roll call: three yeas. *Motion* by Lamb with a second by Rollin authorizing *Resolution 2021-55* amending appropriations as presented. Roll call: three yeas.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

WATER BOARD- Lamb: answer to the previous question, there was a 2% increase in 2020 / 2021, Finance committee will meet and discuss any possible increase. Hydrant maintenance reports need to be formally requested. Lanning to send email to Lora Rollence requesting the reports.

LORCO- Lamb: Lieutenant Governor visited to present the million-dollar grants received. Cinnamon Lake and West Salem will benefit from the grants. There is approximately 1.7 million funded and grant money received. Still in talks with Avon Lake over finances.

AMBULANCE- Holmes: Year to date runs for Huntington 122 with 63 coming out of the Huntington satellite. October runs for Huntington were 16 with 8 coming out of the satellite. The total year to date for the entire district is 1472. Dave Fisher is replacing Nancy Fisher on the Board. The satellite is credited for making quick response times.

SHERIFF- Deputy Sprouse: 23 calls in October with 21 incidents of campers broken into at Clar Mar (Twin Lakes). Mostly alcohol was taken during the break ins.

FIRE- Rollin: Reapplying for grant money for radios, Fish fry for the firemen and Board members is 11/24/2021.

SWAC- Finkel: received estimate on Stewart Road culvert replacement. Filed the ODOT grant paperwork Saturday. Issues with computer are being worked out. SWAC is getting rid of a new flail type mower, never used. It is a three-point hitch with 9- or 10-foot bar. *Consensus* to allow Finkel to investigate pursuing purchasing the mower.

ZONING BUSINESS/NEWS- Finkel: Discussion on updating the Zoning for ponds, meeting tomorrow. A pond construction should be developed by a Registered Civil Engineer. Rollin: a dam over 3 feet is inspected by ODNR.

THRIVE & OFFICE ON AGING- Rollin: nothing

CEMETERY- Lanning: call from Shannon Quast asking to be allowed burial on #278 EAST. Shannon to provide document with living heirs: Beverly Roice, Judith Roice and Mindy Simms stating approval for Shannon Quast burial in #278 EAST. *Motion* by Holmes with a second by Lamb to "hold" lot #278 EAST in the records for burial of Shannon Quast upon receipt of document from living heirs. Roll call: three yeas. David Hollingsworth called inquiring about any available lots in Evergreen or East Center Cemeteries. Finkel: there are 4 lots available in Evergreen on the West side by pine trees and none on the East

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side of Center Cemetery. Lanning to relay information to Mr. Hollingsworth. *Motion* by Rollin with a second by Lamb to authorize the removal of trees and stumps in the Cemetery as needed. Roll call: three yeas.

ROADS and EQUIPMENT: Holmes: culvert at 25111 Baker Road is sliding in, request Finkel look at the issue. Finkel: repaired the rotten bottom of radiator in the road grader and put it back together. Call received from John Ternes about an invoice for installation of a culvert pipe. He is not being given the lease for the farm land in 2022 and therefore will not be paying for a culvert. Land is owned by Mr. Hurdy. Combs: straw tucker is built and looks good, received a second quote on painting the freightliner \$11,000.00. Lamb: the other estimate was about \$6,000.00 from Wellington Autobody. Finkel: suggest we put the painting on hold for a while. Discussion on painting now or at a later date.

RECYCLING- Lamb: discussed when Trustees would open the recycling building, will not open it on Christmas.

TRASH CONSORTIUM- nothing EMPLOYEES- nothing.

PREVIOUS BUSINESS:

Lanning: Received ODOT sidewalk permit with instruction to call ODOT when work begins.

NEW BUSINESS:

Lanning: Go Daddy renewal received, *Motion* by Lamb with a second by Rollin to authorize a 3-year renewal of the website hosting through Go Daddy. Roll call: three yeas. Ohio department of taxation now requiring any employer with over 10 W2's must remit them to State of Ohio electronically through the Ohio Business Gateway.
