January 2017 - Quarterly Report

In November, HFCCW held a Thanksgiving Dinner for our monthly general meeting. It was a potluck dinner, complete with Turkey and all the trimmings. It was well attended.

During the month of November 2016, there were three funerals in our parish. At two of the funeral luncheons, we had over 150 people in attendance. The support of the CCW and other women in the parish is greatly appreciated.

HFCCW held a Fall Bake Sale in November. We had a large donation of baked goods from many of the women in the parish. We earned over \$360 from the sale.

In December, HFCCW had our annual Christmas party. We had a \$10-\$15 gift exchange game. The event was well attended. Everyone was invited to bring their favorite snacks or desserts to share.

HFCCW donated \$500 to the Lantern House in December to assist them in providing gifts to the children in their shelter. Many of the women who are active in our CCW also provided gifts to the children on the Giving Tree that is sponsored by the parish. The majority of those children are participants at Give Me A Chance. In our parish, the HFCCW President was also responsible to provide the appetizers for the annual New Year's Eve party held in the parish.

HFCCW will be hosting the quarterly Northern Deanery meeting on February 11, 2017, at 9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Everyone is encouraged to attend. It is requested that those who are planning to attend to RSVP by February 8th, so as to plan accordingly for the food.

3. Saint Rose CCW held its annual Bake Sale and Raffle in December. The Knights were having their bi-monthly breakfast, so those three groups were working all together in the Social Center. Each group commented on how great it was to have each group together instead of working separately as before. 4. At our January meeting we had an infant Jesus shower and potluck dinner. It was well attended and we received quite a few gifts to take to the CCS.
5. This weekend, January 28th and 29th our Deacon Bernardo will be ordained. Once again each of the groups at Saint Rose is hosting a reception after each mass in his honor to congratulate him. The CCW will host the Sunday 10:30 mass with cake and coffee for the entire parish.
6. On February 10th the CCW is holding a family valentine Spaghetti Dinner. The dinner is free to the parish, but we will accept donations.
7. In March at our normal meeting we will announce our Woman of the Year and have a potluck dinner.
