The new TPPC League competition has started. March's distance is 10 shots at 7 yards. Turn your target(s) into Leonard at the April's Members meeting. Then pick up your April target(s). It is not too late to join the competition; your 7 best targets will count towards the competition.

License to Carry (LTC) Practice: These are held every other Thursday night from 6:00 to 8:00 PM. The next dates for the March 16th and 30th. Daytime LTC practice on Tuesday 21st at 9:00 AM. The participants get the opportunity to practice drawing from their concealment with their everyday carry pistols. All participants are closely monitored to provide a safe and fun atmosphere. There are multiple scenarios and barricades to practice various aspects of defending oneself if the situation ever presents itself.

Action Pistol: Practices and holds their events every other Wednesday starting at 6:00 PM. The next one will be on Wednesday the March 8th and 22nd, Our Action Pistol nights offer a safe environment to improve or enhance your gun handling and shooting skills. A perfect opportunity to increase your confidence in daily carry and self-defense. These practices and events are open to ANY safe shooter, you do not need to be an Action Pistol member to participate.

Lady's Night: Lady's nights are typically held on the 3rd Thursday of the month. Our next lady's night will be March 23rd from 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm. You may come at 6:00 or 7:00. There will be a safety briefing, then shooting in the range. Free for members, \$5 for non-members. You may bring your gun, or there will also be pistols and ammo available for use. Minors above 12 years of age are welcome while accompanied by an adult.

Top 5 Restriction of Gun Rights Bills in 2023 Texas Legislature (In no particular order):

- RAISING minimum age to purchase semiauto rifles.
- BANNING private firearm transfers at gun shows.
- CRIMINALIZING the failure of a victim of gun theft to report
- RESTRICTING long gun open carry, with limited exceptions.
- 5) ESTABLISHING a 3day WAITING PERIOD for firearm sales.

Executive Order on Reducing Gun Violence and Making Our Communities Safer

The following synopsis is definitely not an endorsement for Bidens executive action, just providing information to keep everyone informed.

- (a) The Attorney General shall develop and implement a plan to: (i) clarify the definition of who is engaged in the business of dealing in firearms, (ii) prevent former FFLs whose licenses have been revoked or surrendered from continuing to engage in the business. (iii) publicly release, inspection reports of FFL dealers cited for violations of the law; and (iv) support efforts to modernize and make permanent the Undetectable Firearms Act (18 U.S.C. 922(p)).
- (b) The Secretary of Defense (SOD); the Attorney General (AG); the Secretary of Homeland Security (SHS); the Secretary of Health and Human Services (SHHS), including through the Surgeon General (SG)of the United States; the Secretary of Education (SE); and the Secretary of Veterans Affairs (SVA) shall expand existing Federal campaigns and other efforts to promote safe storage of firearms.
- (c) SOD; AG; SHS; the SHH, SG; and SE shall undertake efforts to encourage effective use of extreme risk protection orders ("red flag" laws), partnering with law enforcement, health care providers, educators, and other community leaders.





NRA Armed Citizen from March 2023 Magazines

Early in the morning on Jan. 8, a 51-year-old man out on parole after serving 20 years for armed robbery forced entry into a home in Tangipahoa Parish (near Hammond), La. The man was wearing a ski mask and was armed with a shovel and a lug wrench. Inside the home was a woman and her two young children. A physical altercation took place between the homeowner and the intruder, and the woman was able to defend herself and her children by shooting the stranger. The man was pronounced dead at the scene when officers arrived. The sheriff's office said they believed the woman was justified in shooting the man and that they had also tied the assailant to a violent carjacking that had taken place a few hours prior to the home invasion. - (d) Shall develop a proposal for the President, and submit it no later than September 15, 2023, on how the Federal Government can better support the recovery, mental health, and other needs of survivors of gun violence, families of victims and survivors of gun violence, first responders to incidents of gun violence, and communities affected by gun violence.
- (e) Implement principles to further firearm and public safety practices through the Department of Defense's acquisition of firearms, consistent with applicable law.
- (f) The heads of Federal law enforcement agencies shall, as soon as practicable, but no later than 180 days from the date of this order, ensure prompt entry of ballistics data recovered in connection with criminal investigations into National Integrated Ballistic Information Network (NIBIN).
- (g) Shall work to reduce the loss or theft of firearms during shipment between FFLs and to improve reporting of such losses or thefts, including by engaging with carriers and shippers.
- (h) The Federal Trade Commission is encouraged to issue a public report analyzing how gun manufacturers market firearms to minors and how such manufacturers market firearms to civilians, including through the use of military imagery.
