Unfortunately, CRIME HAPPENS....but what can YOU do to reduce the risk?

As a nearly 40-year-old voluntary group, the Valle Vista Home Owners Association (VVHOA) has our limitations, yet we encourage responsible connections among neighbors to keep an eye out for each other, our area's properties, pets and anyone else visiting our area.

These options help connect our local and nearby areas to hopefully improve safety and keep people alerted to area happenings. Remember that knowledge is power! A recent Greenwood police open-house promoted reporting ALL crimes, even minor, non-damaging ones. If ignored, they can lead to bigger ones if the police are not aware. In the past, VVHOA board has worked with the city & Duke Energy to add and upgrade existing lights for better and safer visibility. Please do your part in helping stop even minor crimes that are now occurring.

- Look around your house at night. Where are the dark areas a thief could hide? Think about improving your exterior with dusk-to-dawn lighting to make it less appealing or adding motion-activated lights in strategic spots if you prefer less constant light
- Consider security cameras with video storage
- Consider removing enticing items from and securing vehicles, securing sheds as best you can and closing garage doors if they do not need to be open
