DESCRIPTION: This budget conscious Shakespeare Sierra is a great looking and performing recurve. Comfortable grip. Imbuaya riser. Brazilian Rosewood overlays have been added to the tips to beautify and strengthen them. Riser is in near mint condition. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. I refinished the limbs, and in so doing was not able to save the original silk screen decals. Current decals are a reproduction. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.

Comes with a new string.

Note: I put this bow to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours) to assure that the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed.
