My Brethren,

Regrettably, the person who calls himself the Lone Ranger has once again tried to spread misinformation among you with a publication he calls the "Wings of Victory". It is regrettable because the information that he has spread is, as has so frequently been the case, not correct and appears to be another apparent effort to mislead you.

I can only assume that since this Lone Ranger was not in court during the negotiations, initiated by the MTAB before the trial could get started, that he simply received incorrect information which he did not apparently attempt to verify before publishing his misleading letter.

The actual terms of the settlement that was arrived upon were set forth explicitly on the record before the judge.
