

ORDINANCE NO. 186

An Ordinance amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 16 of the City of Rolla, North Dakota, requiring licenses of hawkers and peddlers, with certain exceptions, but not changing the penalties.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of Rolla, North Dakota:

Section 1. That Section One of Ordinance No. 16 of the City of Rolla, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1: License for peddling what, what excepted. No person shall be allowed to travel from house to house or place to place in the City for the purpose of carrying to sell, exposing for sale or selling any goods, wares or merchandise, or hawk or peddle such goods, wares or merchandise from vehicles or temporary apparatus not constituting an established place of business subject to local real or personal property taxes, unless he shall have first obtained a license as a hawker and peddler as herein-after provided. Provided, however, that no license shall be required for peddling or vending or marketing products raised or grown on land within this State, nor shall such license be required of bona fide legal residents of this City selling services or goods therein.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the 13th day of September, 1956
