Clergy Column

Today's first reading is the story of Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden. We see very clearly man's age-old sin. Neither Adam nor Eve are willing to take responsibility for eating the forbidden fruit. They both try to pass the blame along. Adam blames it on Eve, and Eve blames it on the serpent. Too often we think of the forbidden fruit as magical, as a fruit that instantly gives knowledge and power to the person who eats it. I suspect that it was simply ordinary fruit from a particular tree that God had told them not to eat from as a test of their obedience. It was not necessary that this fruit be magical, or poisonous, or bad for you to eat in order for it to be a sin to eat it. The mere fact that someone who you know loves you has asked you not to do a certain thing, should be enough for you to avoid doing it. If we truly love someone and know that he or she loves us, then the simple request is sufficient reason. What is clear is that Adam and Eve loved themselves more than God and they valued their own willfulness more than they valued their relationship with God. How often do we make the same choice in different circumstances? How often do we decide we know better than God, and decide that his mere request that we do or refrain from doing a thing is not a good enough reason to obey. Here is the bottom line: if we love God and respect him, then his mere command is enough of a rationale for the way we ought to live.

Flag ay JUNE 14

On June 14, 1777, the Continental Congress approved the design of a national flag. Since 1916, when President Woodrow Wilson issued a presidential proclamation establishing a national Flag Day on June 14, Americans have commemorated the adoption of the Stars and Stripes by celebrating June 14 as Flag Day. Prior to 1916, many localities and a few states had been celebrating the day for years. Congressional legislation designating that date as the national Flag Day was signed into law by President Harry Truman in 1949; the legislation also called upon the president to issue a flag day proclamation every year.

Fathers Day Collection

We will take up the Father's Day collection on the weekend of the ${\bf 16}^{\rm th}$ and ${\bf 17}^{\rm th}$ of June. This collection is very important in that it provides for the health insurance, Medicare and unreimbursed medical and dental expenses for our retired priests. Priests in the Diocese of Crookston may not retire until they are 70 years old (unless their health dictates a rest) and many continue to serve as weekend substitutes, long term substitutes, spiritual directors, chaplains and participants in reconciliation services long after they officially retire. Msgr. Mike Patnode, who most recently served as Pastor of St. Francis de Sales Parish in Moorhead will be featured on the back cover of the May 16th issue of the OND.
