What are the Costs Involved with Installing a Closet System

Self-Installed

If you have a small, basic closet and feel handy with a carpenter's level, cordless drill and tape measure, the do-it-yourself systems can be a wonderful and affordable option. But always make sure to follow all the directions carefully and use the tools suggested by the manufacturer. Make sure that the system you buy will fit your closet and that you anchor into the wall studs. Drywall will not hold up shelving on it's own, so you have to make sure you are anchoring into the wall studs. Also keep the manufacturer's customer service phone number handy in case problems arise, and take advantage of online instructional videos that many manufacturers now offer.



Pro-Installed

If you don't feel so handy with tools and have the budget, you can get a closet storage system professionally installed. An average pro-installed walk-in closet costs about \$1,500 to \$3,500+ or more for materials and installation, but their expertise and experience can help you avoid costly mistakes in the long run. Other than having to clean everything

out of your closet, hiring someone to design and install your closet system is much easier.

The total cost really depends on the size of your closet and the type of system you choose. Going for a basic system with hangers and shelves will generally cost you less than more elaborate systems with extras like cabinets and drawers.

There are some basic pro-installed closet systems that can cost under \$1,000 (wire

base) but there are some extremely high-end walk-in closet projects with all the bells and whistles that can cost more than \$50,000. To avoid sticker shock, do some research on the kind of system that appeals to you and feels like the best fit for your home. Above all – hire a professional. This type of project is very hard to do on your own to make sure that everything fits.

Salted Butter Apple Galette with Maple Whipped Cream

Ingredients

1/4 stick salted butter 1/2 tsp vanilla extract

- 1 pound apples
- (peeled and sliced)
- 4 tbs brown sugar
- 1 large egg
- 1 tbs white sugar
- 2 cups heavy cream
- 2 tsp pure maple syrup
- 1 package puff pastry





Preparation

- In a saucepan melt butter, add vanilla and brown sugar - reduce until it has a syrup consistency
- Preheat oven to 375
- Line a sheet pan with parchment paper
- Roll out puff pastry on a floured surface and transfer to sheet pan
- Arrange sliced apples on top overlapping and leaving a 1 1/2" border and pull sides and ends of pastry over the apples
- Brush apples with butter/sugar mixture and sprinkle white sugar on top
- Beat egg then brush on pastry before baking 40-50 minutes
- Beat cream in a medium bowl to soft peaks
- Fold in maple syrup and serve with the gallette
