Officer Positions to Open

The following nominations opened on January 11, 2021.

- President
- Vice President
- Secretary
- Treasurer
- NEA Delegate
- FEA Delegate

Qualifications

- Candidates elected as President will also serve as a delegate to the National Education Association Convention and the Florida Education Association Convention.
- The President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer must have been members in good standing and have had two previous years of continuous membership before their nomination.
- NEA and FEA Delegates must be members in good standing.

Terms of Office

- The term of office for President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer will run for two years, beginning June 1, 2021, and ending on May 31, 2023.
- The term of office for NEA and FEA Delegate will be for 2021 only.

Convention Delegates

Nominations are also open for SCSBDA delegates to the NEA Representative Assembly and FEA Delegate Assembly.

- NEA Representative Assembly, July 2 - 6, 2021, Denver, CO. You can be a locally funded delegate or a state funded delegate. You must declare if you want to be on one or both ballots. (dates and location subject to change)
- FEA Delegate Assembly, October 2021 in Orlando, FL. You must declare if you want to be on this ballot. (dates and location subject to change)

Nominations

Nominations opened on **January 11, 2021 and will close on March 5, 2021.**

- Nominations may be made in writing and must be received by the SCSBDA Elections Chairperson at the SCSBDA Office located at 813 Orienta Ave., Altamonte Springs, Florida, no later than **5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 5, 2021**, via fax, courier, email, regular mail, or hand delivery.
- Members may send email nominations to seminole.uniserv@floridaea.org.
- Nomination forms are available upon request but are not required.
- Any member in good standing can nominate candidates and run for office if they meet the qualifications above.
- Candidates must accept the nomination via email, phone call, or written letter to the SCSBDA Office before nominations close on March 5, 2021.

A member shall be permitted to self-nominate or be nominated and run for **only** one position per election. A member can be on **one or all three** of the Convention Delegate ballots.

Candidate Information

SCSBDA Elections Guidelines packets describing the requirements of campaigning and campaign materials will be distributed to members who accept nominations. **Candidates must sign the Election Guidelines at the UniServ Office prior to campaigning.**

Vote-By-Mail Election

The election will be vote-by-mail only. The SCSBDA Election Committee will mail additional information regarding the election and how to vote, to your last known home address shared with SCSBDA at the close of nominations.
