All Registration forms must be forwarded by mail with a check for \$90.00, which is nonrefundable (unless on a full scholarship). No reservations will be made without your reservation form and deposit sent to the Secretary/Treasurer. **PLEASE SEND YOUR RESERVATION FORM WITH YOUR DEPOSIT! OTHERWISE NO RESERVATION!** Postmark will determine priority.
