

# Bailey Wins In Jacobsen Open Again

Al Bailey, semifinalist in the 1965 National Public Links tournament, repeated as champion of the Jacobsen Open golf tournament at the Indian Creek Country club Monday.

Bailey shot a pair of one-over-par 35s to win with a 70 in the tournament that annually pushes in Iowa golf competition. A year ago he fired 31-38—59.

Jon "Jack" Smith of Marion and Bob Fry, Davenport pro, tied for second with 71s.

Rich Wall of Cedar Rapids was among six who tied for 10th with 75s, but few had a more bizarre round than Rich. He started out with a double-bogey six on the first hole. Then he knocked in his approach shot from the middle of No. 2 fairway for a birdie-two. On No. 3 his tee shot struck a tree, but again Rich holed out his approach for another birdie-two.
