Hereford Hogs: A Way of Life for the Schulte Family

Just a short drive down a few gravel roads south of the small lowa town of Norway, lowa will take you to a rustic looking farm with a big, square farm house. This farm is the home of the original Hereford hogs. Even 80 years later, the Hereford hog is still a prominent part of not only this farm site but also the lives of the family that still lives there. The Schulte family, in particular the Orlan Schulte family, and his herd of registered Hereford hogs continue the tradition.

It was back in 1926 when John Schulte began to take the vision of creating a pig looking like his beloved Hereford cows and make it into a reality. John began to create what we now know as the Hereford hog by breeding particular lines of Duroc and Poland China and then line-breeding and back-breeding to produce a pig that would resemble the popular breed of Hereford cow. The Hereford hog which John developed and what we still know today has the distinguishing look of a red body with a white face, white feet, and underline. With the help of other breeders throughout the Midwest John Schulte was able to make the Hereford hog breed grow and prosper. Later, John Schulte would also form the recording association that is now known as the National Hereford Hog Record Association (NHHRA).

From the beginning of the NHHRA the Schulte family has been very active not only with the Hereford breed but also with the day-to-day operations associated with a purebred association. John Schulte was the original president of the NHHRA in 1934 with his son, Bernard and grand-son Orlan Schulte both serving as president of the NHHRA at some time during the next 80 years. Daughter in-law, Sylvia Schulte, served as the NHHRA's treasurer/secretary for a number of years, and grand-daughter in-law Deb Schulte has also served on the NHHRA board-of-directors. Over the years the Schulte family has been an integral part of not only the Hereford breed but also the NHHRA.

Today Orlan Schulte with his wife Deb (Daily) who have been married 38 years and their four children: Jayson, Jessica, Hannah and Luke continue to carry on the tradition of the Hereford hog breed. Orlan currently has 35 registered Hereford sows of which he sells breeding stock, show-pigs, butcher hogs and feeder pigs that are fed by Ethan Book of Knoxville, IA and sold to high-end restaurants in the Des Moines, Iowa area. Orlan has been active within the Hereford breed since he was very young and attended his first Hereford National Show and Sale in South Dakota when he was only two years old. During his younger years Orlan showed Hereford pigs at the Benton County Fair and Dubuque County Fair. Orlan showed his Champion boar at the Hereford National Show and Sale in Dubuque, IA in 1977. That boar was called Oly Silver and many offspring were distributed over the entire U.S. Since that first Champion boar, Orlan and his family have shown many Champions with the most recent champions being Reserve Champion boar at the 2009 National Hereford Show and Sale in DeWitt, Iowa, Champion Bred Gilt at the 2012 National Hereford Show and Sale held in Fairfield, Iowa and Reserve Champion Bred Gilt at the 2014 National Hereford Show and Sale held in Belvidere, Illinois. Orlan Schulte and family have also raised a number of very influential boars that have been widely used to improve the Hereford breed: Pack leader, Big Bill, Big Ben, as well as many others.....These boars have not only been used to produce other great Hereford boars but also great brood sows. Over the years Orlan has also introduced a number of farmers to the Hereford breed by selling boars, gilts and bred gilts in order for the Hereford breed to continue to grow. One thing those new breed enthusiasts are guaranteed when they purchase breeding stock from Orlan is they will be getting sound and hardy animals that will breed naturally in all types of facilities while also maintaining the traditional Hereford hog markings.

 to transfer is an additional \$3.00 for each transfer on top of the
 registration fee.
- If you sell them and need them transferred after you receive the
 pedigree, there is a place on the back of the pedigree to fill the
 new owners name, address and date sold. The cost to transfer
 is \$3.00 for each transfer.
